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## Passport Detail in PNR's and Duplicate segments

Just a reminder that all PNR's must have passport details entered. Also, please do not hold dupe segments in PNR's, as this will trigger an auto-cancelation on all SAA flights. This then will require re-booking at current availability and reissue of ticketed bookings with ADCOL and fees.

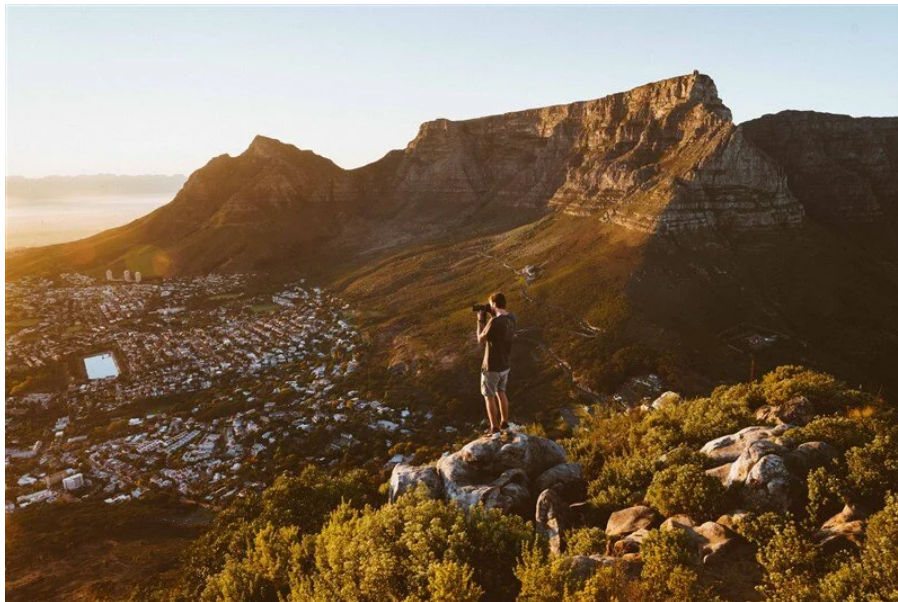
#### How to Get Around

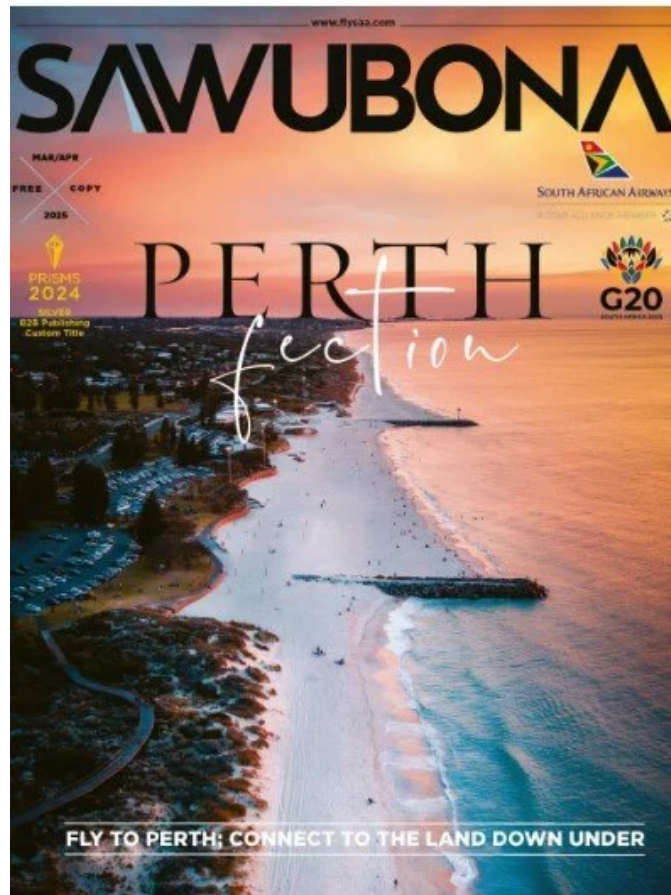
